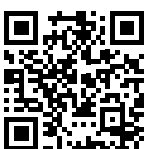

## The Symposium for Gifted Education

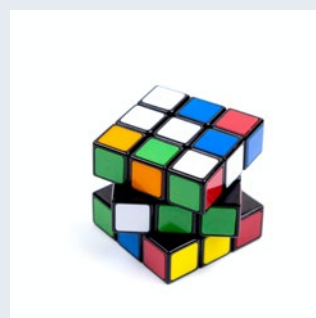

This multi-media lecture will resource teachers with an overview of classical ideas of truth and logic and the role of contemporary social media in re-shaping these ideas. The session will consider some of the best ways to show gifted students how logic functions, looking particularly at deduction, induction and abduction, as well as the place of logic in post-modern reasoning.
